- Canadian geography (1 credit-Grade 9)
- Canadian history (1 credit-Grade 10)
- The arts (1 credit)
- Health and physical education (1 credit)
- Civics ( $1 / 2$ credit-Grade 10) Careers ( $1 / 2$ credit-Grade 10 )
