RETURNING

Decisions will be based on behaviour, attendance and commitment to learning

Students will fill in a returning form with reason for return

Students will have an interview with an administrator to discuss return

Students will take the courses they need – every effort will be made to get courses in the same semester

STUDENT ACTIVITY FEE

Students can take only the courses they require (min 2)

Payment must be completed on school cash online, forms to be digitally signed here.






