- Mathematics (3 credits, with at least one in Grade 11 or 12)

- French as a second language (1 credit)
- Canadian geography (1 credit-Grade 9)
- Canadian history (1 credit-Grade 10)
- The arts (1 credit)
- Health and physical education (1 credit)
- Civics ( $1 / 2$ credit-Grade 10 ) Careers ( $1 / 2$ credit-Grade 10 )

- Need more assistance getting started
- Typically bound for college, trades or work




## Locally- Developed Grades 9 \& 10

## Best for students who:

- Small Teacher: Student ratio
- Slower Pace
- Learn by doing
- Require additional support in the classroom
- Typically bound for work or trades
