


# Graduation Photos

- ▶ Ontario scholar a student must achieve an average of at least 80% in their best six Grade 12 courses, which can be taken over multiple years

Loran Award – \$100,000 over 4 years + additional awards of \$5,000 or \$2,000. Deadline Oct. 12<sup>th</sup>. Applicants should demonstrate strength of character, integrity, courage and grit. 
