- 1. Points for areas of involvement must be assigned by the appropriate staff advisor/supervisor. Please contact the teacher to determine the number of points assigned, and include this total, and the staff name in the appropriate section so the points can be verified upon receipt.
- 2. The application form must be returned to **Mrs. Charnish-Currie** no later than <u>3:00 p.m. on May 12th 2023</u>. Please contact Mrs. Charnish-Currie for any questions or concerns.
- 3. Points can be earned at any time during the years at Holy Trinity Catholic High School.
- 4. Due to COVID restrictions in the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 school years, students graduating in June 2023 require a minimum of 250 points for a School Letter: The academic area must have a minimum of 150 points. Two other areas must have a minimum of 10 points each.
- 5. Due to COVID restrictions in the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 school years, students in Grades 10 and 11 for the 2022-2023 school year require a minimum of 170 points for a Titan Award: The academic area must have a minimum of 80 points. Two other areas must have a minimum of 5 points each.
- 6. During the student's years at Holy Trinity Catholic High School, the student must have behaved in accordance with the school's Code of Human Relations.
- 7. <u>Achieving</u> the minimum number of **POINTS** for either the School Letter (HT) or the Titan (T) Award **does not mean that it will be automatically granted.** Ultimately, well rounded individuals with points in all areas are the most ideal candidates.
- 8. When calculating points for the academic area mid-term report card marks for the current semester will be used. If final marks increase the final points total will also increase.
