

SCHOOL LETTER (HT) AND TITAN (T) AWARD

1. Points for areas of involvement must be assigned by the appropriate staff advisor/supervisor. Please contact the teacher to determine the number of points assigned, and include this total, and the staff name in the appropriate section so the points can be verified upon receipt.
2. The application form to **Ms. Williams** no later than **3:00 p.m. on May 17th 2024**. If you have any issues with this please contact Ms. Williams in advance via email (twilliams@bhncdsb.ca) for support. Late applications will not be accepted.
3. Points can be earned at any time during the years at Holy Trinity Catholic High School.
4. The minimum number of points required for the school letter is **250** points:
 - (i) academic area must have a minimum of 150 points.
 - (ii) two other areas must have a minimum of 15 points each.
5. The minimum number of points required for the Titan award is **170** points:
 - (i) academic area must have a minimum of 80 points:
 - (ii) two other areas must have a minimum of 10 points each.
6. During the student's years at Holy Trinity Catholic High School, the student must have behaved in accordance with the school's Code of Human Relations.
7. Achieving the minimum number of **POINTS** for either the School Letter (HT) or the Titan (T) Award **does not mean that it will be automatically granted**. Ultimately, well rounded individuals with points in all areas are the most ideal candidates.
8. When calculating points for the academic area mid-term report card marks for the current semester will be used. If final marks increase the final points total will also increase.

The School Letter will be considered for those graduating students who achieve the following:

Area 1 - ACADEMICS	-	minimum of 150 points
Area 2 - CLUBS AND ORGANIZATIONS	-	minimum of 15 points
Area 3 - ARTS	-	minimum of 15 points
Area 4 - SPORTS	-	minimum of 15 points

A minimum of **250** points must be accumulated.

Academics and community volunteer service completion are compulsory; points must be earned in **at least 2 other areas**.

THE TITAN (T) AWARD

The Titan Award will be considered for those students who achieve the following:

Area 1 - ACADEMICS	-	minimum of 80 points
Area 2 - CLUBS/ORGANIZATIONS	-	minimum of 10 points
Area 3 - ARTS	-	minimum of 10 points
Area 4 - SPORTS	-	minimum of 10 points

A minimum of 170 points must be accumulated.

Academics and community volunteer service completion are compulsory; points must be earned in **at least 2 other area**.
