GUIDANCE DEPARTMENT—REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Your child received a form outlining the step-by-step process to **online registration.** Registration for 2017/18 began February 13th during which time students also received grade-specific presentations. If your child did not bring home the step-by-step instructions, please access it under www.trinitycatholic.ca and click the registration tab. The course calendar can also be accessed here as well.

Please ensure the online application is completed at home. The Course Selection Sign-Off sheet and payment will be collected during period one on Tuesday, February 21st and Wednesday, February 22nd.

It is essential that students meet this deadline in order to guarantee course selections.

Parents can use the REGISTRATION CHECKLIST below before submitting their forms:

- —Registration completed online with a total of 8 credits (unless you are taking a spare in grade 12 or returning for a 5th year)
- —Course Sign-Off sheet printed and signed by parent/guardian
- —Payment preferably made on-line using School Cash (instructions enclosed) OR

Cheque for \$55.00 payable to Holy Trinity Catholic High School. Please write your child's name on the memo line of the cheque, OR pay by Cash

Fee Structure:

Full Year Activity Fee: \$55 Semester 1 Activity Fee: \$40 Semester 2 Activity Fee: \$40 Late Fee (forms after Mar 31) \$10
