GUIDANCE DEPARTMENT—COURSE SELECTION INFORMATION

Your child received a form outlining the step-by-step process for **online course selections.** Course registration for 2018/19 began February 12th during which time students also received grade-specific presentations. If your child did not bring home the step-by-step instructions, please access it under www.trinitycatholic.ca and click the registration tab. The course calendar can also be accessed here as well.

Please ensure the online application is completed at home. The Course Selection Sign-Off sheet and payment will be collected during period one on Tuesday, February 20th and Wednesday, February 21st.
