SCHOOL CLIMATE SURVEY

We would like to thank our students, parents, staff and school community for taking part in our school climate survey. By providing us with information that is important to you, particularly in the areas of school safety, inclusive education and mental-health and well-being, you effectively helped guide school planning. Together, you identified what we do well, where we could improve and what your priorities are. Here is how your feedback is making a difference.

The survey questions that we asked:

1. What are your thoughts on your school meeting the educational needs of all of its students?
2. What are your thoughts on your school's safety?
3. What are your thoughts on how student mental health and well-being is supported in your school?

Top feedback 'themes' that we heard are important to you:

- Safety of school entrances
- Mental health awareness and resources
- Career planning

Actions taken as a result of your survey feedback:

- Greater use of floor coverings at school entrances to reduce the potential of slipping
- Students have greater access to counselling with a full-time social worker
- Increased mental health awareness through the Robb Nash presentation
- The development of a School Wellness Committee to support school mental health needs
- Pathways committee and Guidance Department to create more opportunities for students to explore their career planning
- Creation of a single lunch allows students greater access to teachers, counsellors and school activities (clubs, intramurals, Students' Council, etc.)
