

#### **PLEASE NOTE:**

Parents dropping off students – Please be aware that the front of the school is for Wheel Chair Buses, please do not park in this location.

Students parking at school need to park in the designated spots only; failure to follow this will have students lose the privilege of parking on school property.

#### **Uniform Policy Reminders**

Shoes must be solid black. No logos or stitching of any other colour. Dress shoes are recommended.

Sandals must be solid black, no other colours. They must be solid on the foot. Beach or sport sandals are not appropriate.

Kilts can be no shorter than 4 inches from the middle of the knee. Students in violation of the kilt rule will be given one verbal warning and a letter home. Subsequent infractions will result in students being required to wear uniform pants for the duration of the semester.

Jumpers have been discontinued, they can no longer be worn.



All Students will be expected to log into the online portal to review their transportation details. The portal will be made **available to the public starting on August 15, 2017.**

- We were pleased to celebrate our students' accomplishments last week at the Graduation Ceremonies on Thursday, June 29th. We graduated 207 students of which 82 students received the Ontario Scholar Award and 23 graduated with a Specialized High Skills Major.
- The McCarthy uniform store at HT will be open Monday to Thursday from July 24<sup>th</sup> to August 31<sup>st</sup> from 10a.m. to 2p.m and August 23<sup>rd</sup> from noon til 8pm. The in-school store will also be open on Tuesdays and Thursdays throughout the school year from 11a.m. to 3p.m.

- Timetable change forms will be available in the office for any of the following reasons:
  - a) Failed a course that needs to be put into a timetable.
  - b) Took a summer school course that needs to be taken out of a timetable.
  - c) A student who wishes to make a level change i.e. applied to academic, university to college
  - d) A student in grades 9 – 11 with only 7 or less courses in their timetable.Guidance counsellors will process these requests in the first week of school. Please ensure that a parent/guardian has signed the timetable change form.
- Classes start on September 5<sup>th</sup> at 8:55 a.m. If you are unable to begin classes at that time, for whatever reason, contact the attendance office at 519-429-3600, ext 302.


