Here's how to Register Online:

Step 1: Please go to: https://bhncdsb.schoolcashonline.com

Step 2: Register by selecting the "Get Started Now" and following the steps.

Step 3: After you receive the confirmation email, please select the 'click here' option, sign in and add each of your children to your household account.

Uniform Policy Reminders

Shoes must be solid black, no logos or stitching of any other colour.

Dress shoes are recommended.

<u>Sandals must be solid black</u>, no other colours. They must be solid on the foot. Beach or sport sandals are not acceptable.

Kilts can be no shorter than 4 inches from the middle of the knee. Students in violation of the kilt rule will be given one verbal warning and a letter home. Subsequent infractions will result in students being required to wear uniform pants for the duration of the semester.

Jumpers have been discontinued, they can no longer be worn.

R.J. McCarthy shorts are permitted and should not be altered in any way.

GRADE 9 EXAM PREPARATION WORKSHOPS

TLC will be offering exam preparation workshops for grade 9 students writing their first set of high school exams.

November 20-24, 2017: Study Skills and Time Management

Students will learn how to generate a study schedule to balance the process of writing four exams and finishing four culminating activities. The work they completed throughout the year counts for 70% of their final grade and exams/culminating activities count for 30% of their final grade.

They will also learn different methods of creating study notes -- cue cards, online interactive tools and foldables.

December 11-15, 2017: How to Effectively Study for and Write Exams

Students will learn effective ways to use their study notes, as well as, tips and tricks to writing exams. For example, strategies to write multiple choice, short answer and long answer questions.

EQAO MATH TEST REMINDER

NEWS FROM THE GUIDANCE OFFICE

The Guidance Counsellors have been busy meeting with each of our grade 9 and grade 12 students, welcoming grade eights to our school and visiting with students as they sign up for appointments.

We request that you encourage your senior level students (grade 11 AND 12 students) to visit the colleges and/or universities to which they are planning to apply. Many of the colleges and universities have open houses and tours. A busload of students did venture over to Simcoe Composite for the Ontario University Fair. We recommend that students check out campus tours/open house dates at college websites and www.electronicinfo.ca for university visits.

The deadline for applying to college is Feb. 1st, 2018. College students are encouraged to apply before Christmas holidays as colleges are able to review applications as early as late November. Workshops on how to apply to college took place November 15th and 16th. We encourage you to review the college website www.ontariocolleges.ca with your child and visit college campuses as well (if they are not affected by the strike).

The deadline for applying to university is January 17th, 2018. University students are also encouraged to forward their applications before Christmas holidays. A tutorial session was held period 2, November 14th in the lower cafe – students received their PIN numbers at the end of the session and they are now able to apply.

For those students interested in the trades, there will be a workshop on January 17th. Students may sign up in Guidance.

The "Financing Your Education" workshop and Gr. 12 Parent Information session held on Oct. 18th was well attended. Information was provided by King's College, University of Western Ontario, on scholarships, bursaries, OSAP and relevant websites for all students. If you are a parent or student wanting to check out scholarships go to www.trinitycatholic.ca, click on Student Services and click on "Scholarship and Bursary Package". You will also see a link to the information we provided at the Financial night in October. Encourage your child to continue seeking ongoing scholarship and bursary information. It is also a good idea to check with your employer and organizations to which you belong to see if they offer scholarships/bursaries for your child.
