

SCHOOL LETTER (HT) AND TITAN (T) AWARD

1. Points for areas of involvement must be assigned by the appropriate staff advisor/supervisor and **confirmed with a signature**. If advisor/supervisor is no longer available print the name in the space available for staff advisor/signature. **Must be signed at the time of the event – not years afterward.**
2. The application form must be returned to the **Main Office – Mrs. Nepp-Wirag** no later than **3:00 p.m. on April 26th 2019.**
3. Points can be earned at any time during the years at Holy Trinity Catholic High School.
4. The minimum number of points required for the school letter is 250 points:
 - (i) academic area must have a minimum of 150 points.
 - (ii) two other areas must have a minimum of 25 points each.
5. The minimum number of points required for the Titan award is 170 points:
 - (i) academic area must have a minimum of 80 points:
 - (ii) two other areas must have a minimum of 15 points each.
6. The community volunteer service area can receive credit from school volunteer work or community volunteer work. Indicate the areas of volunteer service.
7. During the student's years at Holy Trinity Catholic High School, the student must have behaved in accordance with the school's Code of Human Relations.
8. **Achieving** the minimum number of **POINTS** for either the School Letter (HT) or the Titan (T) Award **does not mean that it will be automatically granted.**
9. Ultimately, students who are well-represented in all areas are the most appropriate choices.
10. When calculating points for the academic area use mid-term report card marks of the current semester. In the case of applicants where final marks would increase the final point total would also increase.

The School Letter will be considered for those graduating students who achieve the following:

Area 1 - ACADEMICS	-	minimum of 150 points
Area 2 - CLUBS AND ORGANIZATIONS	-	minimum of 25 points
Area 3 - ARTS	-	minimum of 25 points
Area 4 - SPORTS	-	minimum of 25 points
Area 5 - COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER SERVICE		

A minimum of 250 points must be accumulated.

Areas 1 and 5 are compulsory and points must be earned in at least 2 other areas.

Community service hours must be **in addition** to the graduation requirements and must be documented.

THE TITAN (T) AWARD

The Titan Award will be considered for those students who achieve the following:

Area 1 - ACADEMICS	-	minimum of 80 points
Area 2 - CLUBS/ORGANIZATIONS	-	minimum of 15 points
Area 3 - ARTS	-	minimum of 15 points
Area 4 - SPORTS	-	minimum of 15 points
Area 5 – COMMUNITY VOLUNTEER SERVICE		

A minimum of 170 points must be accumulated.

Area 1 and 5 are compulsory and points must be earned in at least 2 other areas.

Community service hours must be **in addition** to the graduation requirements and must be documented.
