## Superintendent of Education Pool

The Brant Haldimand Norfolk Catholic District School Board invites applications for the Superintendent of Education Pool. Successful applicants to the pool will be eligible for placement as Superintendents of Education for the Board.

The successful applicant will have a demonstrated commitment to the ideals of Catholic Schools; superior communication and interpersonal skills; demonstrated involvement within a parish community and demonstrated curriculum leadership.

Reporting to the Director of Education, as a member of the senior administration, the successful candidate will be responsible for:

- The supervision of a family of schools, principals; and
- Other functions related to system level portfolios.

### Qualifications:

- Supervisory Officer's Certificate from the Ontario Ministry of Education (or ability to complete qualifications in accordance with the *Education Act*);
- Demonstrated problem-solving skills and the ability to foster positive working relationships with staff and parents;
- Demonstrated ability to lead student achievement initiatives in schools;
- Preference will be given to candidates with a Religious Education Specialist certificate or an academic background in Religious Education;
- Preference will be given to candidates with experience as a principal in at least two of the following areas (secondary school principal, elementary school principal or district-level principal) OR experience as a Supervisory Officer;
- Leadership experience in Special Education and Human Resources is an asset; AND
- Member in Good Standing with the Ontario College of Teachers.
